The Bible says that each person is wonderfully and fearfully made by a wonderful, fear-inducing, awe-inspiring God. Each person is made to relate to others, and this reflects how God has made each person to be in a relationship with Him. God wants to love you and bless you. That is His purpose for you and for your little one.

In the Bible, there is a blessing that God gives. It says:

“The LORD bless you and keep you;

The LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you;

The LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace.” (Numbers 6:24–26)

Every time your baby turns their face towards you, it feels like your whole world lights up, like the sun shining on you. But, this is nothing compared to the light of God turning His face towards you in love.

God longs for you to look up and turn to Him. He loves you and He wants you to love Him in return.

God has always wanted to be in a relationship with you. But, we have all turned our backs on Him, choosing to go our own way and reject Him. This is what the Bible calls “sin”. As a result, our relationship with God is broken.

The good news, though, is that God's very own Son, Jesus Christ, has made this relationship possible again. Wonderfully, Jesus Himself was born as a baby and the purpose of His life was to bring you to God. When Jesus died on the cross He dealt with the sin which separates us from God. If we put our trust in His death, and turn from our own way to God's way, then God promises forgiveness and the hope of eternal life.
