Everything has been done so that you too can have your sins forgiven. God, out of His great love, offers you salvation through Jesus Christ.

None of the singers we quoted died for your sins. None of them can give you peace or grant you eternal life. But the

Lord Jesus is different. He is the Prince of Peace, God clothed in humanity. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. If we trust Him, we can find peace and eternal life when we die.

We don't know what your last words will be, but we do wonder what your next words will be. Will they be to turn from all your sins and believe in Jesus for salvation?


# The songs they sing can touch our hearts. That's why many people love them and listen to their music over and over again.

#### Freddie Mercury


