and into the lane little sheep went to play.

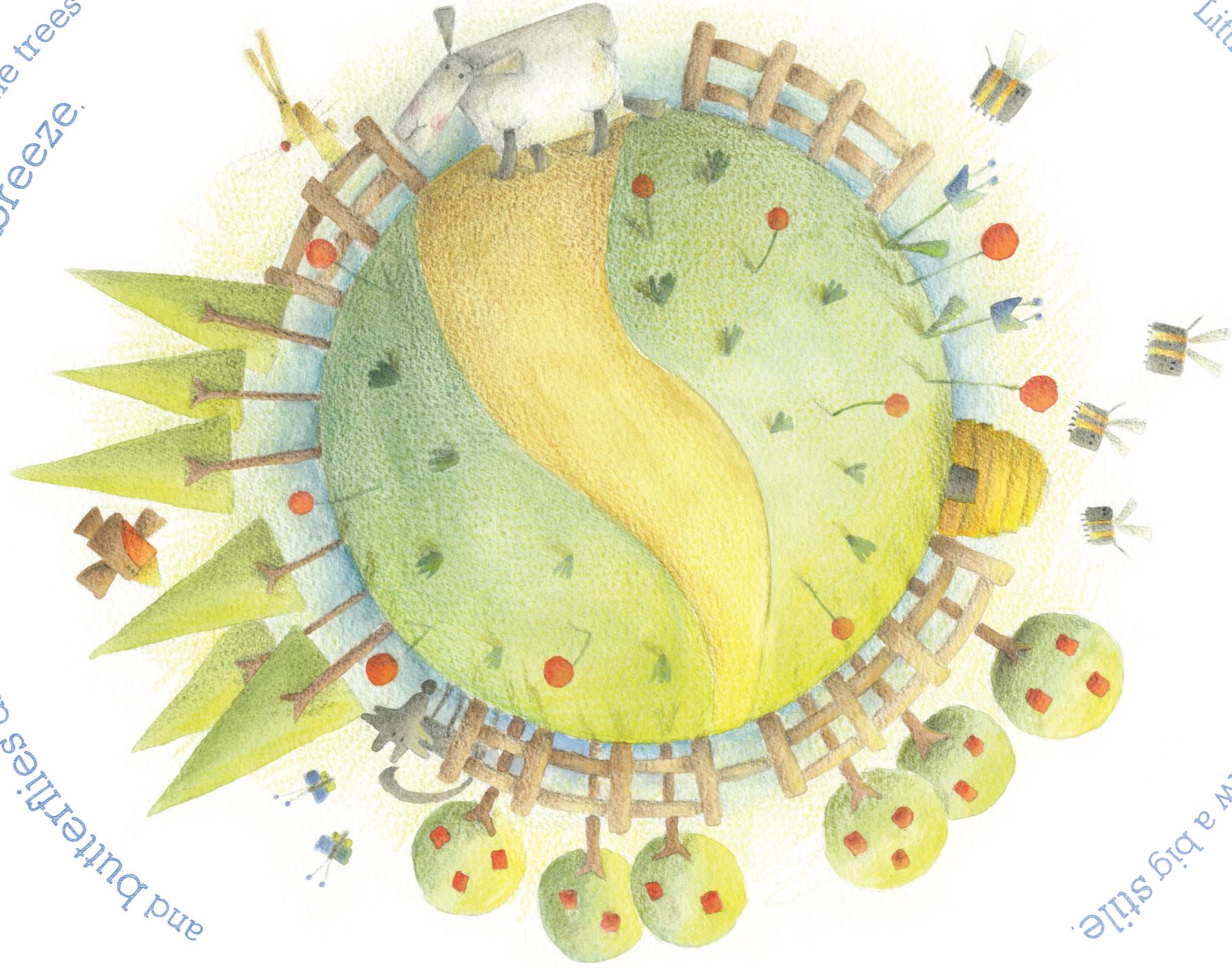




The Shepherd had told of the danger outside,
