Join the dots to draw the angel and then colour the angel in.

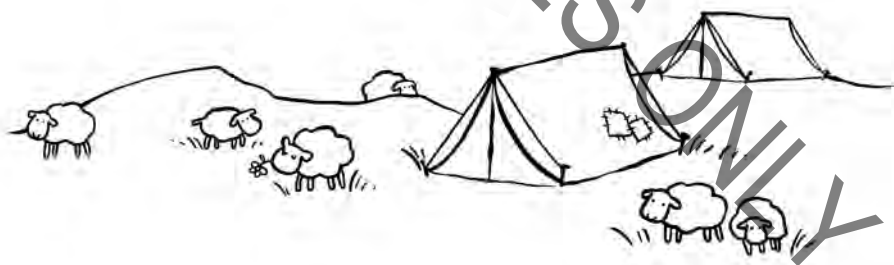
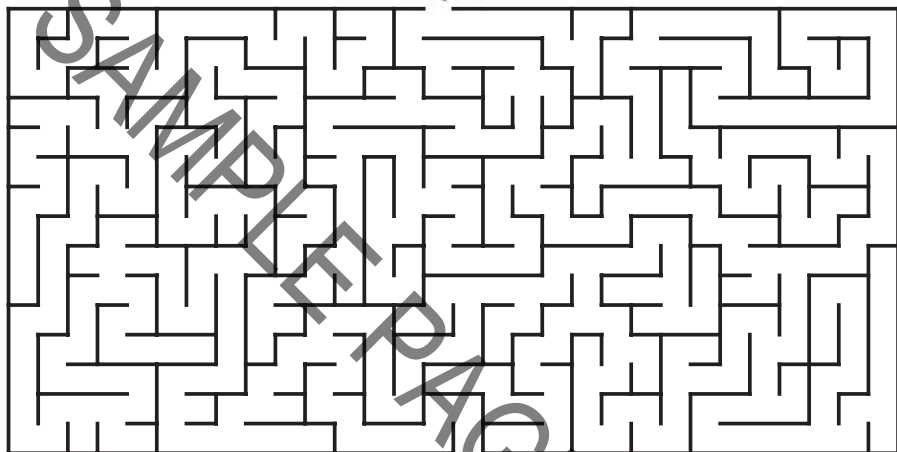
Colour in the shepherds and draw some grass for them to walk on.



The shepherds said to each other, “Come on, let’s go into Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has told us about.”




Help the shepherds find their way home.

What it means...

angel: a messenger who has really **good news** from God

joy: the really good news will make lots of people happy

today: Jesus was born a long, long time ago, so the angel said ‘today’ way back then

Saviour: someone who saves or rescues you from something

Christ the Lord: this means Jesus is the King—the loving boss of everything and everyone

As you've learned in this book, Christmas is about the birth of a special baby named Jesus.

Why is Jesus special? Well, the angel said Jesus is special because he is Christ the Lord and Saviour. That means he is the King sent by God to be a rescuer. Jesus rescues people so they can be God's friends.

That's why this book is called **The Christmas King**—because Christmas is the true story of God's rescuing King being born.
